Excursions and Activities

Several excursions for international students are planned each semester and are included in the semester fee. These excursions are designed to expose students to historic cities and popular events in the region. Previous trips have included visits to Charleston, Greenville and Columbia, South Carolina, and Savannah, Georgia (locations subject to change).

In addition to excursions, Southern Semester students are able to participate in a variety of student events on campus. Typical activities include sporting events, student art shows, plays, movie nights, guest lecturers, band performances, community service and much more.

Courses

PC offers 32 different majors: the most popular being biology, history and business. International students will be able to choose from any class taken by American students and will enroll in these courses alongside PC students. Top course choices for international students include business, English, psychology and history classes. The average class size is 15 students, giving you an easy opportunity to meet and learn from your classmates and PC's outstanding faculty.
