Once arrived in Montpellier, you can go to the "Espace Logement Etudiant" exhibition at the Montpellier City Hall from mid-August to beginning of September 2018. You will find help and small ads to find a shared apartment or any accommodation.

**IMPORTANT:** Reservations are for 4 or 10 months. You will pay your rent until the 31<sup>st</sup> of December 2018 for the 1<sup>st</sup> semester or until 15<sup>th</sup> of June 2019 for the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester, even if you leave earlier.

## **PROCESS:**

- 1. If there is availability in one of our public dormitories, an email message will be sent automatically with a code to enter the software of the CROUS (French University Housing Service) called INTERLOG.
- 2. You will have to connect, select your room and dormitory and fill in the form on line.
- 3. A few days later, you will receive an accommodation proposal which might be different from what you asked, depending on the availabilities.
- 4. Then you will have to pay for the safety deposit online with a credit card. This payment commits you to take the room you have booked and you won't be entitled to change room once you have moved in the residence.
- 5. You will be able to print a certificate of accommodation, directly from the Interlog online application.
