

Admission Requirements	Have completed at least two semesters of study at the home university before mobility, proof of language proficiency, recommended GPA 2.75 or above
Language Courses	The University offers a range of language courses in its <u>language</u> <u>centre</u> .
Course Registration	The exchange program coordinator of the Lucerne University of Applied Sciences and Arts will do the course registration for you according to your predefined learning agreement, except for language courses. For those you must enrol yourself (information follows after application).
Transcripts of Records	Transcripts are generally available few weeks after the final exams. The exchange program coordinator will send the official transcript to the student's home institution and a copy to the student by email.
